- 1) Some months have 31 days. How many have 28?
- 2) How many birthdays does the average African man have?
- 3) Do they have their own fourth of July in the country of England?
- 4) In baseball, how many outs are there in one inning?
- 5) Can a California man legally marry his widow's sister?
- 6) Divide 30 by $\frac{1}{2}$ and add 10.
- 7) If there are 3 apples and you take away 2. How many do you have?
- 8) A farmer has 17 sheep standing in a field. All but 9 drop down and die. How sheep are left standing?
- 9) A male clerk in the butcher shop is 5'10" tall. What does he weigh?
- 10) How many two cent stamps are there in ONE dozen?
- 11) Which statement is true: The yolks of an egg IS white. OR The yolks of an egg ARE white.
- 12) How many members of each animal did Moses take on the ark?



ANSWERS

1) Some months have 31 days. How many have 28?

A: All of them. Every month has at least 28 days.

2) How many birthdays does the average African man have?

A: One. The day you are born is your birth day.

3) Do they have their own fourth of July in the country of England?

A: Yes. It comes immediately after July 3rd.

4) In baseball, how many outs are there in one inning?

A: 6 outs. 3 at the top if the inning and 3 at the bottom.

5) Can a California man legally marry his widow's sister?

A: No. If the man has a widow, the man is deceased.

6) Divide 30 by $1/2$ and add 10.

A: 70. It is not 25 (30 divided by 2 would be 15 30 divided by $1/2$ is 60).



7) If there are 3 apples and you take away 2. How many do you have?

A: You would have 2 because YOU took them away.

8) A farmer has 17 sheep standing in a field. All but 9 drop down and die. How sheep are left standing?

A: Nine, because all but nine drop down and died.

9) A male clerk in the butcher shop is 5'10" tall. What does he weigh?

A: Meat. The butcher cuts the meat, the clerk weighs it.
